

City of Aiken Dial-A-Dumpster Program

City of Aiken Neighborhood and Development Services Division has initiated a program that will help low to moderate income residents keep their yards and neighborhoods clean year-round. The Dial-A-Dumpster program is designed to give a group/neighborhood access to a dumpster in their area for a weekend for the purpose of disposing of large, unwanted items. This is a free service. Just follow a few simple steps. You may also call 642.7779 for more information.

1. Meet with your Association/neighbors and determine if you can use a dumpster. This application requires the signature of five residents of the same area.
2. Once you have gathered the signatures, **turn your application in to the Neighborhood and Development Services Division, 655 Kershaw Street NE.** *The person listed on the first line is the person who will be used as the point of contact and they must be present when the dumpster is dropped off.* The Public Works Department will determine the best location in your area to place the dumpster.
3. Please be sure to include your requested drop off and pick up dates. Every effort will be made to accommodate your request. You will be notified within 2 business days after you drop off the application of your scheduled Dumpster Day.
4. Public Works will provide a list of restricted materials. Make sure that your dumpster is not filled with any hazardous materials. Also, please make sure not to fill the dumpster above the fill line marked on the outside of the dumpster.
5. **In order to provide this service equally for qualified City residents, only one dumpster day per year will be scheduled per neighborhood group.**
